



TRI-CANYON AREA

Mill Creek, Big Cottonwood, and Little Cottonwood Canyons make up what is known as the Tri-Canyons. These three canyons are easily accessed by nearly 2 million people along the Wasatch Front. All three provide backcountry recreation opportunities.

Due to the need to protect watershed resources (as mentioned earlier in the book), Mill Creek Canyon is the only canyon in the tri-canyon area where dogs are allowed. Dogs **MUST** be leashed in the entire canyon on even-numbered days and are allowed to be unleashed on odd-numbered days except in developed areas. Dog owners are required to clean up after their dogs. No domestic animals are allowed in either Big or Little Cottonwood Canyons. Please respect the valuable water resources of the Wasatch Front.
